- 6 deemed always open for filing papers, issuing and returning
- 7 process, and issuing orders."
- 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2024.
