# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part IX to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "\\$201- State film liaison; establishment. (a) There
- 5 is established within the creative industries division of the
- 6 department a state film liaison to plan, develop, and execute a
- 7 statewide film industry development strategy to include all
- 8 counties in the State for the purposes of establishing a
- 9 collaborative film industry development program.
- 10 (b) The state film liaison shall be appointed by the
- 11 director of business, economic development, and tourism without
- 12 regard to chapter 76.
- (c) Each position existing within the film branch of the
- 14 creative industries division of the department as of the
- 15 effective date of this Act shall retain the civil service status
- 16 and duties of the respective position."

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$65,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to
- 4 establish and fill one full-time equivalent (1.00 FTE) state
- 5 film liaison position exempt from chapter 76, Hawaii Revised
- 6 Statutes.
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 8 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
- 9 this Act.
- 10 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
