HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU AND HONOLULU POLICE DEPARTMENT TO ADDRESS THE ONGOING HOUSELESSNESS CRISIS AND DEVELOP SOLUTIONS FOR PROVIDING CARE AND SERVICES FOR THESE INDIVIDUALS WHILE ENSURING COMMUNITY SAFETY.

WHEREAS, Hawaii has one of the highest rates of 1 homelessness in the nation, with forty-six out of every ten 2 3 thousand people in Hawaii being reported as homeless; and 4 5 WHEREAS, in addition to posing a direct risk to the health 6 and safety of affected individuals, homelessness also serves as an added stressor or contributing factor in many crimes; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, as of September 30, 2021, the 'Ohana Zone program has served five thousand sixty-seven individuals and placed 10 eleven hundred twenty-nine individuals into permanent housing; 11 12 and 13 14 WHEREAS, the Homeless Outreach and Navigation for Unsheltered Persons (HONU) program is a mobile facility that 15 provides short-term shelter services and navigation to connect 16 17 homeless individuals and families to longer-term sheltering and other housing options; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, HONU is funded through the 'Ohana Zone program and operated by the City and County of Honolulu's Department of 21 Community Services in conjunction with the Honolulu Police 22 23 Department; and 24 WHEREAS, HONU will rotate through multiple locations on 25 Oahu for a maximum of ninety days at a time; and 26 27 28 WHEREAS, establishing sites to provide HONU services in 29 each City Council district on Oahu and extending the time HONU 30 operates in each site would increase access to transitional services for unsheltered persons; and 31

1 2 WHEREAS, there is a growing concern about violent crime 3 committed by unsheltered persons; and 4 5 WHEREAS, a three strikes program would allow police to 6 detain an individual with a record of committing violent crimes; 7 and 8 9 WHEREAS, Weed & Seed Hawai'i, Inc., is a community-based organization that works with law enforcement to reduce crime in 10 communities and develop community solutions to crimes in 11 12 neighborhoods; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Weed & Seed Hawai'i has site programs located in downtown Honolulu, Waipahu, and Ewa Beach; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, homelessness is a multifaceted issue and expanding various existing initiatives that target specific elements of 18 the homeless crisis, particularly better access to services and 19 reducing crime, is an important step in addressing homelessness 20 21 in Hawaii; now, therefore, 22 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 24 Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, that the City and County of Honolulu and Honolulu 25 Police Department are requested to address the ongoing 26 27 houselessness crisis and develop solutions for providing care and services for these individuals while ensuring community 28 29 safety; and 30 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City and County of Honolulu and Honolulu Police Department are further requested to 32 establish HONU sites in each City Council district on Oahu and 33 extend the time HONU operates in each site beyond ninety days; 34 35 and 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Honolulu Police Department is requested to implement a three strikes program to allow for 38 39 the detention of an unsheltered person with a record of three or 40 more counts of assault; and 41

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Honolulu Police Department is further requested to work with Weed & Seed Hawai'i, Inc., to 2 3 develop community policing solutions to address violent crime committed by or occurring within the homeless population in the 4 5 Waianae Coast community; and 6

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 8 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City and County of 9 Honolulu, Interim Chief of Police of the Honolulu Police Department, and President of Weed & Seed Hawai'i, Inc. 10
