## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF ADMINISTRATIVE VICE PRINCIPAL DEAN OF STUDENTS FOR THE LAHAINALUNA HIGH SCHOOL BOARDING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Lahainaluna High School is a public school located 1 2 on the Island of Maui that serves approximately one thousand 3 students; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Lahainaluna High School Boarding Program, founded in 1836, offers students the opportunity to take 6 advantage of the school's academic offerings and the many 7 community, club, athletic, and work programs; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, the Lahainaluna High School Boarding Program welcomes students from across the State and internationally who 11 are interested in a Lahainaluna education and boarding life 12 experience; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, the Lahainaluna High School Boarding Program is committed to its students and their development as leaders and 16 self-sustaining contributors to society; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, the management of the Lahainaluna High School Boarding Program poses a unique endeavor that traditionally 20 trained principals may not be experienced in; and 21 22 WHEREAS, a Lahainaluna Boarding Department Working Group 23 24 was convened in October of 2014 to develop a vision, mission, 25 and purpose for the Lahainaluna High School Boarding Program; 26 and 27 WHEREAS, the Lahainaluna Boarding Department Working Group 28 made several recommendations for the Lahainaluna High School 29 30 Boarding Program, including: 31
