## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR PRESIDENT THEODORE ROOSEVELT HIGH SCHOOL.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, founded in 1930 and
- 2 situated in Makiki on the island of Oahu, President Theodore
- 3 Roosevelt high school has grown to serve an enrollment of more
- 4 than one thousand four hundred students. The school's existing
- 5 gymnasium and music building were constructed over fifty years
- 6 ago and do not meet current department of education standards.
- 7 The legislature provided funding for plans and design for a
- 8 master plan for a new gymnasium, new music building, and
- 9 additional on-site parking in Act 106, Session Laws of Hawaii
- 10 2012. The final master plan, DOE Job No. Q22000-13, dated
- 11 December 23, 2014, presented the preferred master plan for:
- 12 (1) A new gymnasium over a one-level parking structure at
- the site of the existing gymnasium; and
- 14 (2) A new two-story music building and repurposing of the
- existing music building.

- 1 The legislature also provided funding for plans and design
- 2 for a new gymnasium with locker rooms, classrooms, and other
- 3 related facilities necessary to provide equitable opportunities
- 4 for girls and boys in Act 49, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017.
- 5 The legislature provided funding for design and
- 6 construction of the new gymnasium, including parking below and
- 7 around the gymnasium, and bus and vehicle access improvements in
- 8 Act 40, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding for the
- 10 implementation of the master plan for the new gymnasium for
- 11 President Theodore Roosevelt high school.
- 12 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
- 13 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$18,000,000 or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
- 15 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2021-2022
- 16 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects as
- 17 follows:
- 18 1. President Theodore Roosevelt High
- 19 School
- 20 A. Design and construction for a new
- 21 gymnasium with locker rooms,

1	classrooms, and other related
2	facilities; parking below and
3	around the gymnasium; bus and
4	vehicle access improvement to
5	accommodate group drop-off and
6	pick-up; ground and site
7	improvements; and equipment and
8	appurtenances.
9	\$18,000,000
10	Total funding \$18,000,000
11	SECTION 3. The sum appropriated for the capital
12	improvement projects set forth in section 2 of this Act shall be
13	expended by the department of education for the purposes of this
14	Act.
15	SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital
16	improvement project authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
17	the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
18	made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
19	unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.
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1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2021.
