RELATING TO CANDIDATE COMMITTEE AND NONCANDIDATE COMMITTEE ORGANIZATIONAL REPORTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 11-322, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to	o read as follows:
3	"§11-	-322 Organizational report, candidate committee. (a)
4	The candio	date committee organizational report shall include:
5	(1)	The committee's name and address, including web page
6		address, if any;
7	(2)	The candidate's name, address, and telephone number;
8	(3)	The office being sought by the candidate, district,
9		and party affiliation;
10	(4)	The chairperson's name and address and, if appointed,
11		the deputy chairperson's name and address;
12	(5)	The treasurer's name and address and, if appointed,
13		all deputy treasurers' names and addresses;
14	(6)	The name and address of each depository institution in
15		which the committee will maintain any of its accounts
16		and the applicable account number; and



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1	(7) A certification by the candidate and treasurer of the
2	statements in the organizational report.
3	(b) Any change in information previously reported in the
4	organizational report [ <del>with the exception of subsection (a)(8)</del> ]
5	shall be electronically filed with the commission within ten
6	days of the change being brought to the attention of the
7	committee chairperson or treasurer."
8	SECTION 2. Section 11-323, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9	amended to read as follows:
10	"§11-323 Organizational report, noncandidate committee.
11	(a) The noncandidate committee organizational report shall
12	include:
13	(1) The committee's name, which shall incorporate the full
14	name of the sponsoring entity, if any. An acronym or
15	abbreviation may be used in other communications if
16	the acronym or abbreviation is commonly known or
17	clearly recognized by the general public. The
18	committee's name shall not include the name of a
19	candidate;
20	(2) The committee's address, including web page address,
21	if any;



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1	(3)	The area, scope, or jurisdiction of the committee;
2	(4)	The name and address of the committee's sponsoring
3		entity. If the committee does not have a sponsoring
4		entity, the committee shall specify the trade,
5		profession, or primary interest of contributors to the
6		committee;
7	(5)	The name, address, telephone number, occupation, and
8		principal place of business of the chairperson;
9	(6)	The name, address, telephone number, occupation, and
10		principal place of business of the treasurer and any
11		other officers;
12	(7)	An indication as to whether the committee was formed
13		to support or oppose a specific ballot question or
14		candidate and, if so, a brief description of the
15		question or the name of the candidate;
16	(8)	An indication as to whether the committee is a
17		political party committee;
18	(9)	The name, address, telephone number, occupation, and
19		principal place of business of the custodian of the
20		books and accounts;



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1	(10)	The name and address of the depository institution in	
2		which the committee will maintain its campaign account	
3		and each applicable account number; and	
4	(11)	A certification by the chairperson and treasurer of	
5		the statements in the organizational report.	
6	(b)	Any change in information previously reported in the	
7	organizat	ional report[, with the exception of subsection	
8	<del>(a)(12),</del> ]	shall be electronically filed with the commission	
9	within te	n days of the change being brought to the attention of	
10	the commi	ttee chairperson or treasurer."
