#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 134-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) No person who is [ <del>under indictment for, or has waived</del>
4	indictment for, or has been bound over to the circuit court
5	for,] charged with a felony in a court in this State or
6	elsewhere, or has been convicted in this State or elsewhere of
7	having committed a felony, or any crime of violence, or an
8	illegal sale of any drug shall own, possess, or control any
9	firearm or ammunition therefor."
10	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
11	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were

12 begun before its effective date.

13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
