A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE II, SECTION 1, OF THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION TO CHANGE THE AGE QUALIFICATION FOR VOTING IN STATE OR LOCAL ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the age
- 2 qualification to vote in any federal, state, or local election
- 3 is eighteen years of age. However, there are individuals whose
- 4 dates of birth fall between the primary and general elections
- 5 and therefore, due to current age restrictions, are unable to
- 6 participate in state and local primary elections, which
- 7 determine the ballot for the general election in which they will
- 8 later be eligible to vote. Granting voting rights to these
- 9 individuals to participate in the voting process for state and
- 10 local elections may improve voter turnout among youths and
- 11 better educate youths about the democratic process.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to propose an amendment to
- 13 article II, section 1, of the Hawaii State Constitution to
- 14 change the age qualification for voting in certain state or
- 15 local primary elections to include individuals who are seventeen

- 1 years of age but will be eighteen years of age on or before the
- 2 next state or local general election.
- 3 SECTION 2. Article 2, section 1, of the Constitution of
- 4 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:
- 5 "Section 1. Every citizen of the United States who shall
- 6 have attained the age of eighteen years, have been a resident of
- 7 this State not less than one year next preceding the election
- 8 and be a voter registered as provided by law, shall be qualified
- 9 to vote in any state or local election [→]; provided that every
- 10 citizen of the United States who is seventeen years of age but
- 11 will attain the age of eighteen years by the date of the next
- 12 state or local general election, has been a resident of this
- 13 State not less than one year immediately preceding the next
- 14 state or local general election and is a voter registered as
- 15 provided by law, shall be qualified to vote beginning with the
- 16 state or local primary election immediately preceding the state
- 17 or local general election by which the citizen will attain the
- 18 age of eighteen years, and at any co-occurring or intervening
- 19 special election."
- 20 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
- 21 be as follows:

4	this State not less than one year immediately preceding the
5	next state or local general election, and is a voter

11	SECTION 4. Constitutional material to be repealed is
12	bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is
13	underscored.
14	SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
15	compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
16	the State of Hawaii.
