## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that given expanding
- 2 telework options and infrastructure, the hiring of entirely
- 3 remote professionals for certain positions within the department
- 4 of education has the potential to satisfy critical hiring needs
- 5 in a fiscally prudent manner. This is particularly applicable
- 6 to positions in the areas of information technology and online
- 7 learning, as well as other highly specialized positions.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to help satisfy critical hiring
- 9 needs in a fiscally prudent manner by exempting certain
- 10 department of education employees from the state residency
- 11 requirement under section 78-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 12 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, part III, subpart B, Hawaii
- 13 Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be
- 14 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 15 "§302A- Personnel exempt from state residency
- 16 requirement. (a) The department of education may recruit and
- 17 employ professionals under this section, without regard to

20	employed	by the University of Hawaii under the authority of
21	section [-	{]304A-1001[}.] and persons recruited and employed by

- 1 the department of education under the authority of section
- 2 <u>302A-</u>."
- 3 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
