## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SCHOOLS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that current high
- 2 school graduates, as well as non-graduates, would benefit from
- 3 aligning educational curriculum to a workforce readiness
- 4 preparation program. This alignment depends upon close
- 5 collaboration between the department of education adult
- 6 community schools and high schools, community colleges,
- 7 workforce development council, and employers. A workforce
- 8 readiness program would ensure that students learn skills and
- 9 earn credentials required by industry for employment after
- 10 graduation, or for completion of the community school for
- 11 adults workforce preparation program.
- 12 The legislature further finds that collaboration between
- 13 educators and industry employers will enable students to earn
- 14 a community school for adults workforce development diploma
- 15 credential. Students may also earn pre-apprenticeship
- 16 certificates and other certificates, recognized by industry,
- 17 in addition to an associate degree.



- 1 The purpose of this Act is to establish a workforce
- 2 readiness program within the department of education's
- 3 community school for adults program.
- 4 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 5 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
- 6 designated and to read as follows:
- 7 "§302A- Workforce readiness program; establishment.
- 8 (a) There is established a workforce readiness program
- 9 within the department's community school for adults program.
- 10 (b) The department shall designate schools, including
- 11 the community school for adults, to participate in the
- 12 program.
- 13 (c) In addition to offering an associate degree, schools
- 14 participating in the workforce readiness program shall
- 15 provide opportunities for students to earn workforce
- 16 development diplomas, pre-apprenticeship certificates, or
- 17 other certificates recognized by industry to assess and
- 18 document student readiness for a wide range of jobs.
- 19 (d) The department may coordinate with the department of
- 20 labor and industrial relations and the department of human
- 21 services' division of vocational rehabilitation and enter into

- 1 contracts with industry employers to develop and implement the
- workforce readiness program.
- 3 (e) The department may adopt rules pursuant to chapter
- 4 91 to effectuate the purposes of this section."
- 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of S or so
- 7 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 8 the two existing department of education community school for
- 9 adults primary campuses and associated satellite sites to
- 10 implement the workforce readiness program, established by
- 11 section 2 of this Act, in collaboration with the department of
- 12 labor and industrial relations, department of human services'
- 13 division of vocational rehabilitation, workforce development
- 14 council, American job centers, local businesses, hotels,
- 15 employers, apprenticeship programs, and community colleges in
- 16 meeting the demands for a career-ready workforce; and for:
- 17 (1) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position at the
- 18 McKinley community school for adults; and
- 19 (2) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) position at the
- 20 Waipahu community school for adults,
- 21 to implement the workforce readiness program.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
