A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GRANTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, as a result of the
- 2 coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic and its deleterious impact on
- 3 the economy, fiscal resources of the State are limited. As a
- 4 result, there is heightened scrutiny and greater emphasis on the
- 5 most efficient use of existing funds. The legislature further
- 6 finds that it is appropriate to impose more stringent
- 7 requirements on organizations applying for grants from the
- 8 State.
- Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to clarify
- 10 existing, and establish new, grant application process and
- 11 eliqibility requirements for organizations, including nonprofit
- 12 organizations, that may receive a grant from the State.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 42F-102, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 "§42F-102 Applications for grants. (a) Requests for
- 16 grants shall be submitted to the appropriate standing committees

18		<u>(C)</u>	If applicable, proof that the organization is
19			current in the payment of real property taxes;

3		<u>(A)</u>	A copy of the organization's exemption ruling
4			from the Internal Revenue Service evidencing that
5			the organization has been granted tax exempt
6			status under the Internal Revenue Code;
7		<u>(B)</u>	Proof that the organization currently maintains
8			its tax exempt status under the Internal Revenue
9			Code;
10		(C)	If applicable, proof of the organization's
11			compliance with section 467B-2.1; and
12		(D)	Copies of the organization's Form 990, 990-EZ,
13			990-PF, or 990-N filed with the Internal Revenue
14			Service for the organization's prior two taxable
15			years."
16	SECT	ION 3	. Section 42F-103, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

15	nonprofit	organization [only if the organization:] that:

17		currently maintains its status as, a nonprofit
18		organization by the Internal Revenue Service; [and]
19	(2)	Has a governing board whose members have no material
20		conflict of interest and serve without
21		compensation[-];

1	(3)	If applicable, complies with section 467B-2.1; and
2	(4)	Has filed Form 990, 990-EZ, 990-PF, or 990-N filed
3		with the Internal Revenue Service during the
1		organization's prior two taxable years."
