A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE IX, SECTION 6, OF THE HAWAII STATE CONSTITUTION, TO REQUIRE THE STATE AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS TO PLAN FOR THE PRODUCTION OF SUFFICIENT HOUSING INVENTORY TO MEET DEMAND IN THEIR MANAGEMENT OF POPULATION GROWTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Article IX, section 6, of the Constitution of
- 2 the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:
- 3 "MANAGEMENT OF STATE POPULATION GROWTH
- 4 Section 6. The State and its political subdivisions, as
- 5 provided by general law, shall plan and manage the growth of the
- 6 population to protect and preserve the public health and
- 7 welfare[+], which shall include planning for the production of
- 8 sufficient housing inventory to meet projected demand; except
- 9 that each political subdivision, as provided by general law, may
- 10 plan and manage the growth of its population in a more
- 11 restrictive manner than the State. In planning and managing
- 12 population growth, the State and its political subdivisions
- 13 shall ensure that housing production is sufficient to meet
- 14 demand."

4	to include planning for the production of sufficient housing

8	bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is

10	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon compliance with
11	article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of the State of
12	Hawaii.
