## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHIEF PROCUREMENT OFFICERS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is a matter of
statewide concern that the president of the University of Hawaii
serves simultaneously as the chief procurement officer for the
University of Hawaii system. The president of the system
simultaneously serving as the chief procurement officer leads to
inevitable conflicts of interest.

The legislature further finds that across the United 7 States, the vast majority of public higher education 8 9 institutions, including the California State University System, 10 University of Massachusetts System, and University of Oregon System, differentiate between institutional leadership and 11 purchasing when assigning the authority over procurement. While 12 13 the chief procurement officer for the Colorado State University 14 System possesses authority over state purchasing and procurement as well as direct oversight over Colorado's institutions of 15 higher learning, there were no instances in institutions across 16
