### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RESEARCH CORPORATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the research
- 2 corporation of the University of Hawaii, a public
- 3 instrumentality of the State that is administratively attached
- 4 to the University of Hawaii, was established in 1965 for the
- 5 purposes of promoting, encouraging, initiating, developing, and
- 6 conducting scientific research and investigation in all branches
- 7 of learning, and disseminating to the public, the benefits of
- 8 such research and investigation.
- 9 To promote cooperative research projects with private firms
- 10 and persons, the legislature at the time granted the research
- 11 corporation of the University of Hawaii with flexibility in the
- 12 hiring of its personnel and the handling and disbursement of
- 13 moneys by exempting it from state laws relating to reimbursement
- 14 of special funds to the state general funds; advertisement for
- 15 bids and purchases to be made in Hawaii whenever public moneys
- 16 are expended; civil service; compensation; and public



- 1 employment. The legislature finds, however, that over the
- 2 years, the research corporation of the University of Hawaii has
- 3 gradually expanded its undertakings into areas beyond its
- 4 original eponymous purpose, and the benefits of the exemptions
- 5 from statutory requirements have been extended to apply beyond
- 6 what was originally intended by the legislature. For example,
- 7 the research corporation's current website provides that one of
- ${f 8}$  its missions is to "support and enhance . . . development" in
- 9 Hawaii.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to clarify that the purpose of
- 11 the research corporation of the University of Hawaii is to
- 12 promote educational, scientific, and literary pursuits through
- 13 research, training of research personnel, and dissemination of
- 14 knowledge by publication of research findings, and its
- 15 undertakings shall be limited to acts that are reasonably
- 16 necessary to carry out this purpose.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 304A-112, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- "[+] §304A-112[+] Contracts for services for sponsored
- 20 research activities provided by the research corporation of the
- 21 University of Hawaii. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the

- 2 neither the university nor another state agency can [more
- 3 effectively or efficiently] accomplish the purposes of the
- 4 university's sponsored research project and training activities,
- 5 the university shall contract with the research corporation of
- 6 the University of Hawaii established under section [+]304A-
- 7 3001[+] to provide management and other services as described in
- 8 subsection (b) to support the university's sponsored research
- 9 projects and training [activities.] of research personnel who
- 10 are assigned to the projects. [Contracts]
- 11 Services rendered by the research corporation under
- 12 contracts entered into by the university [with] and the research
- 13 corporation pursuant to this section shall be limited to
- 14 providing support services to the university's sponsored
- 15 research [and] projects, as specified in the contract, including
- 16 support services for the training [projects; except that
- 17 university projects supported by funds appropriated by the
- 18 legislature may also be contracted to the research corporation
- 19 pursuant to rules adopted by the board of regents.] of research
- 20 personnel assigned to the project, as specified in the contract.

(4) To receive by gifts, grants, devises, bequests, or otherwise from private sources only, any property, real, personal, or mixed, intangible or tangible, absolutely or in trust, to be used and disposed of, either the principal or the income therefrom, in accordance with the conditions under which it was received; except that no gift to the research corporation shall be accepted unless approved [exception of directors of the income therefore.] as a gift that is beneficial to the research corporation business of research, training of research personnel, and publication of research findings.

0	invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
11	applications of the Act that can be given effect without the
12	invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
13	of this Act are severable.
14	SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
