### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MENTAL HEALTH SCREENINGS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 431M-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) Mental illness benefits.
4	(1) Covered benefits for mental health services set forth
5	in this subsection shall be limited to coverage for
6	diagnosis and treatment of mental disorders[ $\pm$ ];
7	provided that coverage for diagnosis shall include one
8	annual mental health screening. All mental health
9	services shall be provided under an individualized
10	treatment plan approved by a physician, psychologist,
11	licensed clinical social worker, licensed marriage and
12	family therapist, licensed mental health counselor,
13	advanced practice registered nurse, or licensed
14	dietitian treating eating disorders, and must be
15	reasonably expected to improve the patient's
16	condition. An individualized treatment plan approved
17	by a licensed clinical social worker, licensed

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1		marriage and family therapist, licensed mental health
2		counselor, advanced practice registered nurse, or a
3		licensed dietitian treating eating disorders, for a
4		patient already under the care or treatment of a
5		physician or psychologist shall be done in
6		consultation with the physician or psychologist;
7	(2)	In-hospital and nonhospital residential mental health
8		services as a covered benefit under this chapter shall
9		be provided in a hospital or a nonhospital residential
10		facility. The services to be covered shall include
11		those services required for licensure and
12		accreditation;
13	(3)	Mental health partial hospitalization as a covered
14		benefit under this chapter shall be provided by a
15		hospital or a mental health outpatient facility. The
16		services to be covered under this paragraph shall
17		include those services required for licensure and
18		accreditation; and
19	(4)	Mental health outpatient services shall be a covered
20		benefit under this chapter."

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1	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
3	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2023.
