A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII INTERAGENCY COUNCIL FOR TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 226-64, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 The Hawaii interagency council for transit-oriented 4 development shall be composed of the following members: 5 (1) Director of the office of planning and sustainable 6 development, who shall serve as co-chair; 7 (2) Executive director of the Hawaii housing finance and 8 development corporation, who shall serve as co-chair; 9 Chief of staff, office of the governor; (3) 10 Chairperson of the board of land and natural (4)11 resources; 12 (5) Director of transportation; 13 (6) Comptroller; 14 (7) Director of health; 15 (8) Director of human services; 16 (9) Director of public safety;

2	(11)	Chairperson of the stadium authority;
3	(12)	President of the University of Hawaii;
