A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAII COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 206E-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) The authority may, without recourse to public
- 4 auction, sell, or lease for a term not exceeding [sixty-five]
- 5 ninety-nine years, all or any portion of the real or personal
- 6 property constituting a redevelopment project to any person,
- 7 upon such terms and conditions as may be approved by the
- 8 authority, if the authority finds that the sale or lease is in
- 9 conformity with the community development plan.
- 10 For the stadium development district, leases shall not
- 11 exceed a term of ninety-nine years."
- 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
