RELATING TO THE SCHOOL FACILITIES AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-1702, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) The authority shall employ an executive director
- 4 exempt from chapters 76 and 89. The governor shall appoint the
- 5 executive director in the manner prescribed in section 26-34;
- 6 provided that the executive director's term shall be for six
- 7 years, which shall commence on the day the senate advises and
- 8 consents to the executive director's nomination and the
- 9 executive director shall not be limited in the number of terms
- 10 served. If a vacancy occurs during a term, the [governor shall
- 11 appoint an interim executive director whose appointment shall
- 12 expire if the senate does not advise and consent to the
- 13 nomination of an executive director at the next regular session
- 14 of the legislature after the vacancy occurs.] assistant
- 15 superintendent for the office of facilities and operations shall
- 16 serve as the acting executive director until a new executive
- 17 director is appointed and the senate advises and consents to the



- 1 new executive director's nomination. The salary of the
- 2 executive director shall be set by the school facilities board
- 3 and the executive director shall be included in any benefit
- 4 program generally applicable to the officers and employees of
- 5 the State."
- 6 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
