A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 226-106, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (1) Seek to use marginal or nonessential agricultural
 6 land, urban land, and public land to meet housing
 7 needs of extremely low-, very low-, lower-, moderate-,
 8 and above moderate-income households.
 - (2) Encourage the use of alternative construction and development methods as a means of reducing production costs.
- (3) Improve information and analysis relative to landavailability and suitability for housing.
- 14 (4) Create incentives for development which would increase
 15 home ownership and rental opportunities for Hawaii's
 16 extremely low-, very low-, lower-, and moderate-income
 17 households and residents with special needs.
