A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that single-use plastics
- 2 are a serious threat to the State's environmental and economic
- 3 sustainability. Every year, Oahu alone generates more than 2.2
- 4 million tons of waste. Even recyclable plastics require
- 5 extensive processing and must be shipped off-island for
- 6 recycling at great cost.
- 7 The legislature further finds that the department of
- 8 education contributes to the State's annual plastic waste
- 9 through its use of single-use plastic utensils in school
- 10 cafeterias.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to establish a pilot project in
- 12 Molokai's department of education schools to explore the use of
- 13 reusable utensils in school cafeterias.
- 14 SECTION 2. (a) The department of education shall
- 15 establish a reusable utensil pilot project at department of
- 16 education schools on the island of Molokai, that shall commence
- 17 on August 1, 2022, and shall terminate on June 30, 2023.



- 1 (b) The department of education may issue grants to
- 2 establish the pilot project.
- 3 (c) The department of education shall submit a report to
- 4 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
- 5 of the regular session of 2023 on the feasibility of statewide
- 6 implementation of a reusable utensil program.
- 7 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to
- 10 establish a reusable utensil pilot project in department of
- 11 education schools on the island of Molokai.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 13 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
