### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE COMMISSION ON SALARIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 26-56, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 3 "(d) The commission shall convene in the month of November
- 4 2006, and every six years thereafter. [Not] No later than the
- 5 fortieth legislative day of the regular session of 2007, and
- 6 every six years thereafter, the commission shall submit a report
- 7 of its findings and its salary recommendations to the
- 8 legislature, through the governor. The commission may include
- 9 incremental increases that take effect [prior to] before the
- 10 convening of, and remain in effect for the fiscal biennium
- 11 immediately following, the next [salary] commission.
- 12 [The recommended salaries submitted by the commission shall
- 13 become effective July 1 of the next fiscal year] The commission
- 14 that convenes in 2024, shall make salary recommendations through
- 15 June 30, 2033. The commission that convenes in 2030, and each
- 16 commission thereafter, shall make recommendations that take
- 17 effect on July 1 of the first fiscal year of the fiscal biennium

- 1 after the immediately following fiscal biennium in which the
- 2 recommendation was made, unless the legislature disapproves the
- 3 recommended salaries submitted by the commission through the
- 4 adoption of a concurrent resolution, which shall be approved by
- 5 a simple majority of each house of the legislature, [prior to]
- 6 before adjournment sine die of the legislative session in which
- 7 the recommended salaries are submitted; provided that any change
- 8 in salary which becomes effective shall not apply to the

- 13 of the executive branch in the executive budget. If the salary

- 17 legislature's reasons for disapproving its salary
- 18 recommendation. The commission may submit a report of its
- 19 findings and submit a new salary recommendation to the

- 1 reconvening following a legislative disapproval shall not toll
- 2 the six-year cycle."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
