A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
TWELFTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$40,720,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2022-2023
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twelfth
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. McKinley High School

8 A. Athletic complex improvements,
9 including bleachers, locker rooms,
10 stadium and field lighting,
11 related facilities, ground and
12 site improvements, and equipment.

14 Total funding \$18,000,000

15 B. Painting of buildings A through F,
16 and H.

15 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
16 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
17 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
18 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
19 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024 shall lapse as of that date.


1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
3 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

4 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 5 shall be
5 expended by the department of education; and

6 (2) The sums appropriated in items 6 and 7 shall be
7 expended by the department of land and natural
8 resources.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
