## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER CARRIERS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that interisland cargo
- 2 transportation is a lifeline for residents and businesses across
- 3 the state. In particular, interisland cargo is a crucial source
- 4 for islands with smaller populations that rely heavily on
- 5 interisland tug and barge services essential to the State's
- 6 economy. In response to the growing demand for interisland
- 7 cargo transportation, the senate adopted Senate Resolution No.
- 8 125, Senate Draft 1 (S.R. 125, S.D.1), Regular Session of 2020,
- 9 which requested the department of transportation to provide
- 10 funding for uninterrupted interisland water carrier service.
- In 2020, the water carriers working group formed in
- 12 response to S.R. 125, S.D. 1, to develop near-future, mid-, and
- 13 long-term recommendations or actions to establish a two-tiered
- 14 annual rate adjustment process and a broad water carrier
- 15 agricultural cargo shipping subsidy.
- 16 The working group developed the two-tiered system to
- 17 address time-consuming rate cases in response to operational



- 1 expense changes. The creation of a two-tiered system would
- 2 reflect inflation-based cost increases while also providing the
- 3 water carriers opportunities to submit justification to
- 4 recapture expenses. The working group found that the two-tiered
- 5 rate system would create financial sustainability and potential
- 6 profits for water carrier operations in the State.
- 7 The working group also found that broad water carrier
- 8 agricultural cargo shipping subsidies would alleviate costs
- 9 associated with transportation and service across the State.
- 10 Currently, over eighty per cent of goods consumed in Hawaii are
- 11 imported, with ninety-eight per cent of goods transported as
- 12 water borne cargo. Hawaii consumers pay a higher cost for goods
- 13 than consumers in the continental United States, as shipping
- 14 costs are reflected in imported goods consumed and purchased in
- 15 the State. The legislature therefore finds that the subsidy
- 16 program established by this Act is for a public purpose, which
- 17 includes alleviating costs associated with transportation and
- 18 service across the State, primarily for small communities
- 19 reliant on shipment of goods by barge, and providing universal
- 20 support to water carriers, cargo users, and consumers.
- 21 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to:

1	(1)	Before January 1, 2024, require the public utilities
2		commission to establish an annual two-tier water
3		carrier inflationary cost index rate adjustment;
4	(2)	Establish a water carrier agriculture cargo shipping
5		subsidy program to support continuous trans-Pacific
6		and interisland water carrier service, which shall be
7		administered pursuant to the standards and
8		qualifications required for other administrative grant
9		programs in the State;
10	(3)	Appropriate funding to the public utilities commission
11		to establish the two-tier rate adjustment for water
12		carriers; and
13	(4)	Appropriate funding to the department of
14		transportation, harbors division, to fund and
15		implement an interstate water carrier agriculture
16		subsidies program.
17	SECT	ION 2. Chapter 271G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
18	amended by	y adding two new sections to be appropriately
19	designate	d and to read as follows:
20	" <u>§27</u>	lG- Water carrier inflationary cost index. Before
21	January 1	, 2024, the commission shall establish a water carrier

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1	inflation	ary cost index by which water carrier rates shall be
2	annually	adjusted as follows:
3	(1)	Tier one: Automatic rate adjustment for each calendar
4		year shall be calculated by increasing or decreasing
5		the water carrier rate in effect through the end of
6		the previous calendar year by the percentage increase
7		or decrease in the consumer price index for that year;
8		and
9	(2)	Tier two: The water carrier shall request an expense
10		justified rate increase for approval by the
11		commission. The commission shall grant approval based
12		on justification from the water carrier to recapture
13		actual costs and proof of performance measures
14		demonstrating that there has been no material decline
15		in the water carrier's operations, safety, or customer
16		service levels.
17	The total	water carrier inflationary cost index rate adjustment
18	shall exc	lude fuel surcharges and shall not exceed five per cent
19	per calen	dar year. The water carrier inflationary cost index
20	shall not	account for a water carrier's new capital investment.

1	§271G- Water carrier agriculture cargo shipping subsidy
2	(a) There is established a water carrier agriculture cargo
3	shipping subsidy to support continuous trans-Pacific and
4	interisland water carrier service. The subsidies shall be
5	established and thereafter subject to an annual increase of
6	per cent pursuant to subsection (c).
7	(b) The department of transportation harbors division
8	shall administer the subsidy program consistent with the
9	standards and qualifications for making subsidies as previously
10	enacted for other administrative grant programs in the State.
11	(c) The department of transportation shall adopt rules
12	pursuant to chapter 91 necessary for the purposes of this
13	section."
14	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
15	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$200,000 or so much
16	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the
17	public utilities commission to establish a water carrier
18	inflationary cost index by which water carrier rates shall be
19	annually adjusted according to section 2 of this Act.
20	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the public
21	utilities commission for the purposes of this Act.

- 1 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$750,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for an
- 4 interstate water carrier agriculture subsidies program to
- 5 support broad-based interstate and interisland water carrier
- 6 agriculture cargo shipping.
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 8 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.

## Report Title:

Department of Transportation; Public Utilities Commission; Harbors Division; Water Carriers; Rate Increases; Agricultural Subsidy Program; Appropriation

## Description:

Requires the Public Utilities Commission to establish an annual two-tier inflationary cost index rate adjustment for water carriers based on automatic annual increases or a justified increase based on actual costs and performance. Establishes a water carrier agricultural cargo shipping subsidy with an annual rate increase. Appropriates funds. Effective 1/1/2050. (SD1)

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
