## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 55, Session Laws
- 2 of Hawaii 2013, amended the objectives and policies of the
- 3 Hawaii State Planning Act to encourage the purchase and use of
- 4 Hawaii-grown food and food products by residents, businesses,
- 5 and governmental bodies.
- 6 The legislature further finds that the department of
- 7 education serves over one hundred thousand nutritionally
- 8 balanced, affordable meals each day to over eighty-five per cent
- 9 of the youth in Hawaii. A farm to school program can improve
- 10 students' health and academic performance by providing fresh and
- 11 nutritional foods each day.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 13 education to conduct a study to include food hubs in its
- 14 procurement strategy for goods and services related to the aina
- 15 pono Hawaii state farm to school program.
- 16 SECTION 2. (a) The department of education shall conduct
- 17 a study to include food hubs in its procurement strategy for the

- 1 aina pono Hawaii state farm to school program. The study shall
- 2 examine the following:
- 3 (1) The feasibility of including food hubs in the aina
- pono Hawaii state farm to school program;
- 5 (2) Regulatory barriers to including food hubs in the aina
- 6 pono Hawaii state farm to school program; and
- 7 (3) Potential costs or saving associated with including
- 8 food hubs in the aina pono Hawaii state farm to school
- 9 program.
- 10 (b) The department of education shall submit a report of
- 11 its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 12 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 13 to the convening of the regular session of 2023.
- 14 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to
- 17 conduct a study for the inclusion of food hubs in the aina pono
- 18 Hawaii state farm to school program.
- 19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 20 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
