5	(1)	The effect of county ordinances on the Hawaii housing

7		chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes;
8	(2)	Amendments to chapter 201H, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
9		that would allow for increased development of housing
10		where at least sixty per cent of the units are priced
11		as affordable; and
12	(3)	Other topics as necessary to accomplish the purposes
13		of this section.

14 (c) The Hawaii housing finance and development corporation15 shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations,

than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session
 of 2023.

3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
6 the Hawaii housing finance and development corporation to
7 conduct a study on each county's ordinances relating to housing
8 finance and development.

9 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 10 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of 11 this Act.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
