## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARIJUANA.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of business, economic
- 2 development, and tourism shall conduct a study on the potential
- 3 revenue to be generated for the State from the legalization of
- 4 recreational marijuana if it were taxed at a rate equal to the
- 5 existing general excise tax rate.
- 6 (b) The study required under subsection (a) shall include
- 7 a five-year total projection of the potential revenue to be
- 8 generated for the State from the legalization of recreational
- 9 marijuana if it were taxed at a rate equal to the existing
- 10 general excise tax rate.
- 11 (c) The department of business, economic development, and
- 12 tourism may consult with any public or private entity to
- 13 complete the study required under subsection (a). Any public
- 14 entity of the State shall assist the department of business,
- 15 economic development, and tourism by providing information or
- 16 answers to questions at the request of the department, or other
- 17 assistance deemed relevant to the study.



- 1 SECTION 2. The department of business, economic
- 2 development, and tourism shall submit a report of its findings
- 3 and recommendations from the study, including any proposed
- 4 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 5 to the convening of the regular session of 2023.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.

### Report Title:

Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; Marijuana; Legalization; Study; Tax Revenue
