A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to establish two new
- 2 units within the criminal justice division of the department of
- 3 the attorney general.
- 4 SECTION 2. Chapter 28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 5 by adding two new parts to be appropriately designated and to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 "PART . SPECIAL INVESTIGATION AND PROSECUTION UNIT
- 8 §28- Special investigation and prosecution unit. (a)
- 9 There is established in the department of the attorney general a
- 10 special investigation and prosecution unit. The special
- 11 investigation and prosecution unit shall consist of attorneys
- 12 and other specialized personnel necessary to implement this
- 13 section. Each attorney and specialist shall be appointed by the
- 14 attorney general who shall fix the attorneys' and specialists'
- 15 compensation. Every attorney and specialist shall be entitled
- 16 to hold the attorney's and specialist's position during good

1	behavior,	subject to removal by the attorney general only as	
2	provided	in chapter 76.	
3	(b)	The special investigation and prosecution unit shall:	
4	(1)	Receive, gather, and analyze information;	
5	(2)	Develop tactical and strategic intelligence;	
6	(3)	Assist in the control of fraud, white collar crime,	
7		and public corruption;	
8	(4)	Provide technical assistance and training to county	
9		law enforcement agencies in the detection and	
10		prosecution of fraud and white collar crime, and	
11		public corruption; and	
12	<u>(5)</u>	Provide, with the attorney general's approval,	
13		specialized personnel and technological equipment for	
14		the use of law enforcement agencies in the State with	
15		respect to fraud, white collar crime, and public	
16		corruption.	
17	<u>(c)</u>	For purposes of this section, "white collar crime"	
18	includes,	without limitation, crimes that are financially	
19	motivated	and are nonviolent or not directly violent crimes that	
20	are commi	tted by individuals, businesses, and government	
21	professionals.

2	<u>§28-</u>	Sex and Human Trafficking Unit. (a) There is
3	establish	ed in the department of the attorney general a sex and
4	human tra	fficking unit. The sex and human trafficking unit
5	shall con	sist of attorneys and other specialized personnel
6	necessary	to implement this section. Each attorney and
7	specialis	t shall be appointed by the attorney general who shall
8	fix the a	ttorneys' and specialists' compensation. Every
9	attorney	and specialist shall be entitled to hold the attorney's
10	and speci	alist's position during good behavior, subject to
11	removal b	y the attorney general only as provided in chapter 76.
12	(b)	The sex and human trafficking unit shall:
13	(1)	Receive, gather, and analyze information;
14	(2)	Develop tactical and strategic intelligence;
15	(3)	Assist in the control of sex and human trafficking
16		<pre>crime;</pre>
17	(4)	Provide technical assistance and training to county
18		law enforcement agencies in the detection and
19		prosecution of sex and human trafficking crime; and
20	(5)	Provide, with the attorney general's approval,

3	SECT	ION 3. For each of the two units established under
4	section 2	of this Act, the department of the attorney general
5	shall sub	mit an annual report to the legislature no later than
6	twenty da	ys prior to the convening of the regular session of
7	2023, 202	4, and 2025. For each unit, the annual report shall:
8	(1)	Provide aggregated data pertaining to each unit's
9		operation and case dispositions, including the number
10		and type of cases investigated, charged, referred to
11		other agencies, adjudicated with outcome, and closed;
12	(2)	Identify the number and type of personnel employed by
13		each unit, indicate whether any personnel were
14		redeployed or utilized outside of the specialized
15		areas within the purview of the unit, and, as
16		applicable, specify the unit or type of work such
17		personnel engaged in; and
18	(3)	Provide any other findings and information necessary
19		to evaluate the operation and efficacy of each unit,
20		as well as any recommendations or proposed
21		legislation.

1 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$834,000 or so much 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the 4 operations of the special investigation and prosecution unit of 5 the department of the attorney general and to establish the 6 following positions within that unit: 7 Two permanent, full-time equivalent (2.0 FTE) deputy (1) 8 attorney general positions; 9 (2) Three permanent, full-time equivalent (3.0 FTE) 10 forensic analysist positions; 11 (3) One permanent, full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) legal 12 assistant position; 13 (4)Two permanent, full-time equivalent (2.0 FTE) 14 investigator positions; and 15 (5) One permanent, full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) legal 16 clerk position. 17 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 18 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act. 19 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$754,000 or so much

thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the

- 17 clerk position.
- 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 19 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.

- 21 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
