## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that, as the demand for SECTION 1. 2 unskilled labor increases, farmers and ranchers are searching for ways to use technology to better operate their farms. 3 These farmers and ranchers could greatly benefit from foreign 4 5 technology like small equipment tractors from Japan. However, they are unable to import that equipment because it does not 6 7 comply with the Environmental Protection Agency's emission 8 standards.

9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the 10 college of tropical agriculture and human resources, to work in 11 collaboration with a University of Hawaii system community 12 college, for a pilot program to identify and purchase foreign 13 agricultural technology, including small equipment tractors and 14 retrofit engines, which will benefit the State's farmers and 15 ranchers and that complies with the Environmental Protection 16 Agency's emission standards.

1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 2 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 to 3 establish the foreign agriculture small equipment pilot program 4 5 to: Identify and purchase foreign agricultural technology, 6 (a) 7 including but not limited to small equipment tractors and retrofit engines, which will benefit the State's 8 9 farmers and ranchers and comply with the Environmental 10 Protection Agency's emission standards; 11 Establish contact with manufacturers of small (b) 12 equipment in Japan and other countries; Work with the United States Environmental Protection 13 (C) 14 Agency to identify federal Environmental Protection 15 Agency standard and compliance requirements for small 16 foreign agricultural equipment; 17 Collaborate with agriculture and agricultural (d) 18 professionals from foreign countries on management 19 practices;
