BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 486H, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§486H- Retail service stations; dispensing equipment; 5 warning labels. (a) Each self-service gas pump dispensing 6 equipment in a retail service station shall bear or have 7 attached, a plainly written or printed warning label in the 8 English language that provides consumers with information about 9 the impact of fossil fuel consumption. The label shall state 10 that burning gasoline, diesel, and ethanol has major 11 consequences on human health and the environment, including its 12 contribution to climate change. 13 The text, image, or graphics of the warning label in (b) 14 subsection (a) shall be subject to approval from the
