# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO JOINT CONTRACTOR OR SUBCONTRACTOR LISTING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's  
2 procurement process requires clear legislative direction to  
3 award contracts to responsible bidders and to minimize protests  
4 on bids due to the subcontractor listing requirement under  
5 section 103D-302(b), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

6           SECTION 2. Section 103D-302, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
7 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

8           "(b) An invitation for bids shall be issued, and shall  
9 include a purchase description and all contractual terms and  
10 conditions applicable to the procurement. If the invitation for  
11 bids is for construction, it shall specify that all bids that  
12 include the engagement of a contractor or subcontractor in the  
13 performance of the contract shall include the name of each  
14 person or firm to be engaged by the bidder as a [joint]  
15 contractor or subcontractor [in the performance of the contract]  
16 and the nature [and], scope, and specialty or specialties of the  
17 work to be performed by each. Construction bids that do not



1 comply with this requirement may be accepted if acceptance is in  
2 the best interest of the State and the value of the work to be  
3 performed by the [~~joint~~] contractor or subcontractor is equal to  
4 or less than one per cent of the total bid amount."

5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
