A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
- 2 immediate passage in accordance with article VII, section 9, of
- 3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.
- 4 SECTION 2. The State is involved in major litigation that
- 5 could result in costly judgments against it if not vigorously
- 6 defended. These lawsuits will require the State to retain
- 7 expert witnesses and expert counsel.
- 8 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2021-2022 to be
- 11 used by the department of the attorney general in major
- 12 litigation involving the State.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 4. The appropriation authorized under this Act
- 16 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for which the



- 1 appropriation is made; provided that any unexpended and
- 2 unencumbered balance of the appropriation made in this Act as of
- 3 the close of business on June 30, 2023, shall lapse.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
