TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO EARNED INCOME

PURPOSE: To extend the availability of the state

earned income tax credit until tax year

2028.

MEANS: Amend section 235-55.75(g), Hawaii Revised

Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: This bill will extend the state earned

income tax credit (set to expire in 2022) through tax year 2028. This bill provides incentives for taxpayers to work while also reducing the tax burden for low-moderate

income families.

Impact on the public: Eligible taxpayers will be able to claim the state earned income tax credit through tax year 2028.

Impact on the department and other agencies:
The Department of Taxation will maintain its
forms and systems to allow for the claiming
of the earned income tax credit through tax

year 2028.
