A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD CARE GRANT PROGRAMS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT:	ION 1. The purpose of this Act are to:
2	(1)	Rename the preschool grant program special fund to the
3		child care grant program special fund;
4	(2)	Authorize the child care grant program special fund to
5		be used to give grants to child care facilities;
6	(3)	Add federal funds as one of the fund sources for the
7		child care grant program special fund;
8	(4)	Change the legislative report due date for the
9		preschool open doors special fund and the child care
10		grant program special fund from August 31 to twenty
11		days prior to the start of the next legislative
12		session; and
13	(5)	Remove the authority to expend funds without an
14		appropriation for the preschool open doors special

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         SECTION 2. Section 346-182, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
    amended to read as follows:
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         "[+]§346-182[+] Preschool open doors special fund. (a)
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    There is established within the state treasury the preschool
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    open doors special fund, to be administered by the department's
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    child care assistance program, into which shall be deposited all
    moneys received by the department's child care assistance
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    program in the form of:

         (5) Revenues regardless of their source [\tau]; and [earnings]
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         (6) Earnings on moneys in the fund.
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    Moneys in the fund shall be used for the procurement of health
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    and human services under the preschool open doors program.
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Expenditures from the fund may be made by the department without

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- 1 [appropriation or] allotment but shall not be made for capital
- 2 improvement projects.
- 3 (b) The department shall submit an annual report to the
- 4 legislature, no later than [August 31,] twenty days prior to the
- 5 convening of each regular session, on the sources of moneys
- 6 deposited into the fund and expenditures of moneys in the fund."
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 346-183, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:

- 10 fund; established. (a) There is established within the state
- 11 treasury the [preschool] child care grant program special fund,
- 12 to be administered by the department, into which shall be

- 17 (4) Earnings on moneys in the fund [-]; and
- 18 (5) Federal funds received by the department consistent

- 20 (b) The department shall expend moneys in the special fund
- 21 to award [funds] grants to private entities for the operating

- 1 costs of new [preschools] or existing child care facilities, to
- 2 establish new child care facilities, or for expansion of

- 5 (c) Expenditures from the fund may be made by the

- (e) Grants shall be disbursed pursuant to a contract
- 14 between the department or its designee and the grant recipient,
- 15 in accordance with the rules adopted pursuant to subsection (d).

- 17 the legislature [, no later than August 31,] when grant funds are
- 18 received or expended, no later than twenty days prior to the

- 20 deposited into the fund and expenditures of moneys in the fund.
- 21 (g) For the purposes of this section:

- 1 "Grant" means an award of funds to a specified recipient to
- 2 support the activities of the recipient and permit the community
- 3 to benefit from those activities."
- 4 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Department of Human Services; Child Care Grant Programs

Description:

Renames the Preschool Grant Program Special Fund to the Child Care Grant Program Special Fund. Authorizes the Child Care Grant Program Special Fund to be used to give grants to child care facilities. Adds federal funds as one of the fund sources for the Child Care Grant Program Special Fund. Changes the legislative report due date for the Preschool Open Doors Special Fund and Child Care Grant Program Special Fund from August 31 to twenty days prior to the convening of each regular session. Removes the authority to expend without an appropriation for the Preschool Open Doors Special Fund and Child Care Grant Program Special Fund statutes to conform to section 5 of article VII of the Hawaii State Constitution.
