A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MARRIAGE LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 211, Session
2 Laws of Hawaii 2021, authorized the issuance of a civil license
3 to solemnize marriages. Prior to enactment, only individuals
4 with religious affiliations or judicial appointments could
5 obtain a license to solemnize marriages.

6 Act 211, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021, also established fees
7 for a civil license to solemnize marriages, the intent of which
8 was to enhance general revenues from approximately 20,000
9 marriages per year, two-thirds of which are for out-of-state and
10 international couples. However, there are no fees for licenses
11 to solemnize marriages for to apply for the religious and
12 judicial marriage solemnizers.

13 The purpose of this Act is to repeal wording related to
14 fees to assure equity among religious, judicial, and civil
15 performers.

S.B. NO. 3114

SECTION 2. Section 572-12, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

"(b) A civil license to solemnize marriages may be issued to, and the marriage rite may be performed and solemnized by, any individual at least eighteen years of age, upon presentation to the individual of a license to marry, as prescribed by this chapter. An individual with a civil license to solemnize a marriage may receive the price stipulated by the parties or any gratuity tendered. ~~[The civil license shall be valid for no less than two years from the date of its issuance; provided that a temporary three month civil license may be issued upon an individual's request. The fee for a civil license shall be \$100 per year the permit is valid; provided that the fee for a temporary three month license shall be \$25.]~~ An individual who performs a solemnization of a marriage pursuant to a civil license issued under this subsection shall obtain the prior written consent of each person for whom a solemnization is performed and fulfill all provisions of sections 572-13 and 572-15 applicable to persons authorized to solemnize marriages."

SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

DEPARTMENT: Health

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MARRIAGE
LICENSES.

PURPOSE: Repeals the fee required for the issuance of
a civil license to solemnize a marriage.

MEANS: Amend section 572-12, Hawaii Revised
Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: Act 211, Session Laws of Hawaii 2021,
established fees for a civil license to
solemnize a marriage of \$100 for one year
and \$25 for three months. However, there is
no statutorily established fee for religious
or judicial performers to acquire a license.
Repeal of the civil license fee will
establish fairness and parity among license
types.
