# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE OFFICE OF HEALTHCARE ASSURANCE SPECIAL FUND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to repeal the
- 2 ceiling of the office of healthcare assurance special fund.
- 3 This provides greater flexibility for the legislature to review
- 4 spending proposals and for the department to avoid an artificial
- 5 ceiling. The office of health care assurance special funds can
- 6 be used to offset increasing operational expenses, upgrade and
- 7 expand the department of health's management information system
- 8 for the healthcare facility licensing program, implement and
- 9 upgrade a web-based portal for a robust industry-wide background
- 10 check system for criminal history and registry checks on
- 11 healthcare facility licensees and employees, fund state
- 12 licensing surveyor and support positions where general funds
- 13 were eliminated or reduced, and fund other contracts for
- 14 inspection services. Furthermore, in response to the
- 15 coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, there is a need to
- 16 increase public awareness, education, and outreach relating to
- 17 healthcare facilities and agencies to ensure appropriate and

1	high-quality healthcare facility access. Use of these special
2	funds will reduce dependence on the general fund during the
3	COVID-19 pandemic and allow the legislature to use its limited
4	general funds on other critical programs.
5	SECTION 2. Section 321-1.4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:
7	"(b) Moneys in the special fund shall be expended by the
8	department of health:
9	(1) To assist in offsetting operating costs and
10	educational program expenses of the department of
11	health's office of health care assurance; and
12	(2) For the purpose of enhancing the capacity of office of
13	health care assurance programs to:
14	(A) Improve public health outreach efforts, program
15	and community development, and consultations to
16	industries regulated;
17	(B) Educate the public, the staff of the department
18	of health, and other departments within the
19	State, as well as staff and providers of all
20	health care facilities and agencies regulated;
21	and

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1	(C) Administer and support the durable medical
2	equipment supplier license program established
3	pursuant to part XLIII.
4	[Not more than \$327,000 of the special fund may be used during
5	any fiscal year for the activities carried out by the office of
6	health-care assurance.]
7	(c) [Any amount in the special fund in excess of \$387,500
8	on June 30 of each year shall be deposited into the general
9	fund.] Moneys in the special fund may be used during any fiscal
10	year for the activities carried out by the office of health care
11	assurance."
12	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
