# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Act 209, Session Laws of Hawaii 2018, section
- 2 4, as amended by section 1 of Act 128, Session Laws of Hawaii
- 3 2019 is amended as follows:
- 4 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:
- 5 "(a) Contracts entered into by the agencies designated by
- 6 the governor pursuant to the ohana zones pilot program shall be
- 7 exempt from the requirements of chapters 6E, 46, 92, 103D [and],
- **8** 103F, 104, 171, 205, 205A, 206E, 343, and 346, and sections 37-
- 9 41, 37-74(d)(1), 40-66, 102-2, 103-2, 103-53, 103-55, 105-1
- 10 through 105-10, and 464-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes."
- 11 2. By amending subsection (f) to read:
- "(f) The pilot program shall cease to exist on June 30,
- **13** [<del>2023.</del>] 2026."
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 17 the ohana zones pilot program established pursuant to Act 209,

- 2 of Hawaii 2019, including expenses relating to staffing,
- 3 facility construction, provision of services, and administrative
- 4 costs.
- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the
- 6 governor for the purposes of this Act; provided that the
- 7 governor shall transfer the expenditure authority to designated
- 8 executive branch departments or agencies within a reasonable
- 9 time; provided further that except as otherwise provided by law,
- 10 the State shall be the payor of last resort for all expenses
- 11 related to the ohana zones pilot program.
- Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the governor
- 13 may transfer all or a portion of the appropriation in this
- 14 section to the governor's designated executive branch agencies
- 15 for expenditures incurred in implementing the ohana zones pilot
- 16 program.
- 17 The governor's designated executive branch agencies may
- 18 expend any appropriation transferred pursuant to this section
- 19 for the performance of its duties under the ohana zones pilot
- 20 program.

- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.
