# A BILL FOR AN ACT

---

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS BENEFITING AGRICULTURE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue general obligation bonds in the sum of \$954,960 or so much thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the purpose of capital improvement projects, as follows:

1. Ulu Cooperative

A. Construction of refrigerated packing room, including a conventional refrigeration system.

B. Construction of receiving building with scales, including an in-pit commercial scale, ethylene scrubber, and inline water cooler.

9 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital  
10 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at  
11 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are  
12 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are  
13 unencumbered as of June 30, 2024, shall lapse as of that date.

14 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective  
15 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be  
16 expended by the department of agriculture for the purposes of  
17 this Act.

18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
