A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TEACHER PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that there is a severe
- 2 shortage of qualified teachers in public school classrooms
- 3 throughout the State. Each year, the department of education
- 4 looks for approximately one thousand two hundred teachers to
- 5 fill vacancies in early education and kindergarten through
- 6 twelfth grade levels. While the department of education can
- 7 staff most of its positions, the legislature further finds that
- 8 approximately six hundred classrooms statewide are staffed by
- 9 long-term substitutes, rather than full-time teachers.
- 10 The legislature also finds that teacher professional
- 11 development focuses on the provision of a long-term, sustained
- 12 commitment to educational practice through professional
- 13 learning, application, and reflection, and results in enhanced
- 14 student learning. With ample professional development
- 15 opportunities, teachers can be empowered to invest in their area
- 16 of focus and pursue a career educating keiki in Hawai'i. As
- 17 such, the legislature believes that it is incumbent upon the

- 1 State to provide professional development for teachers to
- 2 encourage retention and cultivate a culture of empowerment among
- 3 teachers and principals.
- 4 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 5 funds to the department of education for teacher professional
- 6 development.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for
- 10 professional development of school teachers employed by the
- 11 department of education.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 13 education for the purposes of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.
