# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY IN RURAL DISTRICTS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaiian Ocean View
- 2 Estates, Hawai'i, is one of the fastest-growing subdivisions in
- 3 the United States, with the 2010 United States Census reporting
- 4 a population of 4,864, up from 2,178 as reported by the 2000
- 5 United States Census. The steep growth in population has
- 6 corresponded with a rise in crime, with many residents reporting
- 7 concerns of illegal dumping, abandoned vehicles, property crime,
- 8 and feral dog attacks.
- 9 The legislature further finds that the Hawai'i police
- 10 department currently operates out of a police office in the
- 11 Hawaiian Ocean View Estates subdivision. However, the Hawaiii
- 12 police department cannot process or book arrestees at the
- 13 existing office, and the closest Hawai'i police department
- 14 substation capable of booking and processing is located over
- 15 fourteen miles away in Nā'ālehu. After an arrestee is detained
- 16 and booked, they are then transported to the Hilo or Kona police

- 1 stations for holding. The sheer distance between Hawai'i police
- 2 department facilities on Hawai'i island has resulted in lengthy
- 3 response times for Hawai'i police department service in Hawaiian
- 4 Ocean View Estates, as the same officers assigned to Hawaiian
- 5 Ocean View Estates must transport arrestees to Nā'ālehu and
- 6 thereafter Hilo or Kona, preventing them from responding to
- 7 calls for assistance. The legislature believes that the Hawai'i
- 8 police department's presence in Hawaiian Ocean View Estates must
- 9 be expanded to appropriately respond to reports of crime in the
- 10 area.
- 11 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 12 funds to the county of Hawaii for the plans, design, and
- 13 construction of a police substation to serve the Hawaiian Ocean
- 14 View Estates community.
- 15 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 16 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 17 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for a
- 18 grant-in-aid to the county of Hawaii for the planning, design,
- 19 and construction of a police substation in Hawaiian Ocean View
- 20 Estates, Hawaii; provided that no funds shall be made available

- 1 under this Act unless the county of Hawaii provides matching
- 2 funds on a dollar-to-dollar basis.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the county of
- 4 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2022.

### Report Title:

Hawaii County; Police Substation; Grant-in-Aid; Hawaiian Ocean View Estates; Appropriation

#### Description:

Appropriates funds to the County of Hawaii for the plans, design, and construction of a Hawaiian Ocean View Estates police substation. Requires the County of Hawaii to match funds appropriated on a dollar-to-dollar basis.
