A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 132D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "license" to read as
- 3 follows:
- 4 ""License" means a nontransferable, formal authorization,
- 5 valid for a period not to exceed one calendar year from the date
- 6 of issuance and $[\frac{which}{}]$ that the harbors division of the
- 7 department of transportation is hereby authorized to issue under
- 8 this chapter, to engage in the act or acts specifically
- 9 designated herein."
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 132D-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- "§132D-7 License or permit required[-]; report to
- 13 legislature. A person shall not:
- 14 (1) Import aerial devices, display fireworks, articles
- 15 pyrotechnic, or consumer fireworks unless the person
- has a valid license issued by the harbors division of
- the department of transportation;

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        [<del>(1)</del>] (2) [<del>Import, store,</del>] Store, offer to sell, or sell,
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              at wholesale or retail, aerial devices, display
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               fireworks, articles pyrotechnic, or consumer fireworks
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               unless the person has a valid license issued by the
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               county; or
        [\frac{(2)}{(2)}] (3) Possess aerial devices, display fireworks, or
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               articles pyrotechnic without a valid license to
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               import, store, or sell aerial devices, display
               fireworks, or articles pyrotechnic, or a valid display
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              permit as provided for in this chapter.
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         The harbors division of the department of transportation
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    shall submit a report to the legislature no later than twenty
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    days prior to the convening of each regular session to provide a
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    summary of the licenses issued under paragraph (1); provided
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    that information identifiable to an individual shall be
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    confidential and not subject to public disclosure."
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         SECTION 3. Section 132D-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
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    amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
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         "(a) All licenses required under section 132D-7 shall be
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    issued by the county [and] except licenses to import which may
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    also be issued by the harbors division of the department of
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- 1 transportation; provided that all licenses shall be
- 2 nontransferable. Licenses to import shall specify the date of
- 3 issuance or effect and the date of expiration, which shall be
- 4 March 31 of each year. The application shall be made on a form
- 5 setting forth the date upon which the importations are to begin,
- 6 the address of the location of the importer, and the name of the
- 7 proprietor or, if a partnership, the name of the partnership and
- 8 the names of all partners or, if a corporation, the name of the
- 9 corporation and the names of its officers. The application for
- 10 a license to import display fireworks, articles pyrotechnic, or
- 11 aerial devices shall include written documentation of the
- 12 information required in subsection 132D-8.6(a), proposed display
- 13 event, and related contact information in a form prescribed by
- 14 the applicable county [-] or the harbors division of the
- 15 department of transportation, respectively. If the [state fire
- 16 council or applicable county or harbors division of the
- 17 department of transportation discovers at a later date that a
- 18 licensee has been convicted of a felony under this chapter, the
- 19 licensee's license shall be revoked and no new license shall be
- 20 issued to the licensee for two years."

6	(1)	Clearly designate the types of fireworks or articles
7		pyrotechnic in each shipment on the bill of lading or
8		shipping manifest with specificity;
9	(2)	Declare on the bill of lading or shipping manifest the
10		gross weight of consumer fireworks, display fireworks,
11		articles pyrotechnic, and aerial devices to be
12		imported in each shipment and the location of the
13		storage facility, if applicable, in which the
14		fireworks or articles pyrotechnic are to be stored;
15	(3)	Prior to shipment and when booking each shipment of
16		fireworks, display fireworks, articles pyrotechnic, or
17		aerial devices notify the appropriate state and county
18		official as determined by the <u>harbors division of the</u>
19		department of transportation and county, respectively,
20		regarding whether the shipment will be distributed
21		from:

1		(A) Pier to pier;
2		(B) Pier to warehouse or storage facility; or
3		(C) Pier to redistribution;
4	(4)	Prior to booking the shipment, provide to the
5		applicable state official and county fire chief:
6		(A) Written documentation regarding the proposed
7		display event or events and related contact
8		information to allow the fire chief to validate
9		the importation of a three-month or six-month
10		inventory under section 132D-8.5; and
11		(B) An inventory breakdown for each proposed display
12		and
13	(5)	At the time shipping is booked, the importer or
14		consignee shall notify the appropriate state and
15		county official as determined by the harbors division
16		of the department of transportation and county in
17		writing of the expected shipment's landing date.
18	(b)	The [fire department of a county, in which a shipment
19	of firewo	rks or articles pyrotechnic has landed and becomes
20	subject t	the jurisdiction of the fire department, harbors
21	division	of the department of transportation and the applicable

- 1 county shall be allowed to inspect, if it chooses, any shipment
- 2 declared on the shipping manifest as fireworks or articles
- 3 pyrotechnic."
- 4 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
