BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 10 (3) The sums appropriated in item (11) shall be expended
- 11 by the University of Hawaii.
- 12 (b) The sum appropriated for the capital project set forth
- 13 in section 2 of this Act shall be expended for the purposes of
- 14 this Act by the department of land and natural resources.
