A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC PROCUREMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-707, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§103D-707 Remedies after an award.** (a) If after an
4 award it is determined that a solicitation or award of a
5 contract is in violation of law, then:

6 (1) If the person awarded the contract has not acted
7 fraudulently or in bad faith:

8 (A) The contract may be ratified and affirmed, or
9 modified; provided that it is determined that
10 doing so is in the best interests of the State;
11 ~~[or]~~

12 (B) The contract may be rescinded and awarded to the
13 person the contract would have been awarded to
14 absent the violation; or

15 ~~[-(B)-]~~ (C) The contract may be terminated and the
16 person awarded the contract shall be compensated
17 for the actual expenses, other than attorney's



1 fees, reasonably incurred under the contract,
2 plus a reasonable profit, with such expenses and
3 profit calculated not for the entire term of the
4 contract but only to the point of termination;

5 (2) If the person awarded the contract has acted
6 fraudulently or in bad faith:

7 (A) The contract may be declared null and void; or

8 (B) The contract may be ratified and affirmed, or
9 modified, if the action is in the best interests
10 of the State, without prejudice to the State's
11 rights to such damages as may be appropriate."

12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
