- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 200, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:

4	"§200-	Prohibited	commercial	activities	on beaches.

5 (a) No person shall preset commercial beach equipment on

6 beaches encumbered with easements in favor of the public.

7 (b) For the purposes of this section:

8 "Commercial beach equipment" means recreational equipment

9 for rent, including chairs, umbrellas, surfboards, paddleboards,

10 kayaks, and other non-motorized watercraft equipment.

11 "Preset" means the setting up of beach equipment or

12 watercraft by a commercial vendor without a reservation by a

- 13 customer for the immediate use of the beach equipment or
- 14 watercraft."

15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 17 begun before its effective date.
