
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending the definition of "historic property" to
3 read as follows:

4 ""Historic property" means any building, structure, object,
5 district, area, or site, including heiau and underwater site,
6 [~~which~~] that is over fifty years old[-] and meets the criteria
7 for being entered into the Hawaii register of historic places."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 30, 2075.
