### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 708, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§708- Criminal destruction of a tree on state or 5 county property. (1) A person commits the offense of criminal 6 destruction of a tree on state or county property if, by means 7 other than fire, the person intentionally or knowingly: 8 (a) Fells, injures, or destroys a tree growing or standing 9 upon state or county property to the point of it 10 having no value; or 11 (b) Substantially damages the potential value of a tree 12 growing or standing upon state or county property 13 without the consent of the state or county on which 14 the tree stands. 15 (2) Criminal destruction of a tree on state or county 16 property is a misdemeanor.
