SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO CELEBRATE THE FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LANIKAI BIKEWAY AND RECOGNIZE THE EFFORTS OF TED ROGERS AND CYNTHIA THIELEN WHO LED THE EFFORTS TO ESTABLISH IT.

WHEREAS, the Lanikai Bikeway officially opened on July 1, 1 2 1972, after months of organizing by the Lanikai Association and residents like Ted Rogers and Cynthia Thielen for safer 3 roadways; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Lanikai Bikeway was created in response to a 6 near-fatal incident when the tire of student Linda Bell's 7 8 bicycle hit a rock, which caused her to fall into the roadway; and 9 10 WHEREAS, immediately after her fall, an oncoming vehicle 11 12 came within inches of colliding with Bell's head; and 13 WHEREAS, at the time of Bell's incident, two-way vehicle 14 traffic along Lanikai's narrow roadways left inadequate space 15 for the growing number of bikers in the area; and 16 17 WHEREAS, a survey conducted by Cynthia Thielen and other 18 19 parents in the community counted that approximately six hundred bicycles were in use in Lanikai and most of Lanikai's bicycle 20 riders were children; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, Cynthia Thielen was among a group of concerned parents that proposed a dedicated bikeway and new traffic 24 configuration in Lanikai after Bell's incident; and 25 26 WHEREAS, plans for establishing a one-way traffic loop and 27 bikeway along Aalapapa Drive and Mokulua Drive received 28 widespread approval from the Lanikai community and was the first 29 30 traffic configuration of its kind on the island of Oahu; and





1 WHEREAS, with the support of the Lanikai Association and 2 its president, Ted Rogers, a petition with signatures from two-3 hundred and sixty-two families was successfully submitted to the 4 City and County of Honolulu and plans to build the Lanikai 5 Bikeway and establish the new traffic configuration were 6 approved; and 7 8 WHEREAS, as a direct result of Cynthia Thielen's advocacy 9 and Ted Roger's leadership, the Lanikai Bikeway increased safe 10 bike transportation in Kailua, with an expansion to the bikeway 11 built in 1995; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to honor Ted Rogers and Cynthia Thielen as leaders of distinction who unified the Lanikai 15 community; and 16 17 18 WHEREAS, an official recognition of Ted Roger's and Cynthia Thielen's leadership in advocating for the Lanikai Bikeway will 19 serve as a permanent reminder of their tangible contributions to 20 protecting the community; now, therefore, 21 22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 23 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the 24 House of Representatives concurring, that the City and County of 25 Honolulu is urged to celebrate the fiftieth anniversary of the 26 Lanikai Bikeway and recognize the efforts of Ted Rogers and 27 Cynthia Thielen who led the efforts to establish it; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 30 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of the City 31 and County of Honolulu, Chair of the Honolulu City Council, and 32 President of the Lanikai Association. 33
