SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PROCESS FOR AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECTS IN THE COMMISSION ON WATER RESOURCE MANAGEMENT TO ADDRESS HAWAI'I'S HOUSING SHORTAGE.

WHEREAS, Hawai'i faces a crisis of housing availability and 1 2 affordability; and 3 WHEREAS, the high cost of housing in Hawai'i is primarily 4 the result of insufficient housing production and affordable 5 housing inventory; and 6 7 WHEREAS, while there are numerous barriers inhibiting the 8 9 development of new housing in Hawai'i, one of the most significant is the lack of adequate infrastructure, including 10 infrastructure necessary to deliver potable water; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, the regulation of water resources is administered by multiple agencies at the county and state level, depending on 14 the designation of the water source in question and the quantity 15 of water being used; and 16 17 WHEREAS, installation of water use infrastructure requires 18 approval from the Commission on Water Resource Management, which 19 currently lacks a process to identify and prioritize permitting 20 for affordable housing developments; and 21 22 WHEREAS, after years of permitting new drinking water 23 sources through an administrative process, the Commission on 24 Water Resource Management recently began processing well 25 permits, which has not been a normal procedure for areas that 26 are not designated as a groundwater management area; and 27 28 WHEREAS, without a clearly defined process to respond to 29 permit applications for new drinking water sources, the 30 development of affordable housing in the State will continue to 31



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be delayed by the lack of available potable water; now, 1 2 therefore, 3 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 4 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the 5 House of Representatives concurring, that the Commission on 6 Water Resource Management is requested to develop and implement 7 8 a permitting process that supports the preauthorization for the development of affordable housing throughout the State and 9 10 especially in rural areas; and 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission on Water 12 13 Resource Management is requested to consider the establishment 14 of a water resource management for affordable housing development working group that convenes upon a federal agency or 15 authority's initiation of an inquiry or investigation relating 16 to a permit application order to address the inquiry or 17 18 investigation; and 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission on Water 20 Resource Management is requested to consider the following 21 composition of a water resource management for affordable 22 housing working group: 23 24 25 (1) A member of the Board of Land and Natural Resources; 26 One person designated by the mayor of the county in 27 (2) which the permit application was submitted; 28 29 (3) One person designated by the Department of Hawaiian 30 Home Lands; and 31 32 (4) One person designated by the Department of Water 33 Supply of the county in which the permit application 34 was submitted; and 35 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group's recommendations to remediate the concerns of the federal agency 38 39 or authority should be submitted to the Commission on Water Resource Management, who is requested to then adopt rules in 40 accordance with chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to 41 42 implement the process developed by the working group; and



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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Commission on Water Resource Management.
