SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAIIAN HOMES COMMISSION TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY ON THE CREATION OF AN ENFORCEMENT DIVISION FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS.

WHEREAS, the land trust managed by the Department of 1 Hawaiian Home Lands consists of over two hundred thousand acres 2 across the State; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands has an 5 enforcement section whose role is to investigate complaints from 6 the public and other government agencies dealing with 7 trespassing and other misuses of Hawaiian home lands, initiate 8 actions to evict trespassers, and curtail illegal activities on 9 Hawaiian home lands; and 10 11 WHEREAS, the enforcement section does not have police 12 powers but instead relies on county police or the Department of 13 Land and Natural Resources' Division of Conservation and 14 15 Resources Enforcement for policing Hawaiian home lands; and 16 17 WHEREAS, in February of 2021, the enforcement section and Honolulu Police Department investigated an illegal game room on 18 Hawaiian home lands, and there are reports of other such illegal 19 game rooms in operation; and 20 21 WHEREAS, without police powers, the enforcement section 22 does not currently have the authority to even prevent 23 trespassers from traversing through sensitive Department of 24 Hawaiian Home Lands managed lands; now, therefore, 25 26 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 27 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the 28 House of Representatives concurring, that the Hawaiian Homes 29 Commission is requested to conduct a feasibility study for the 30 creation of an enforcement division with police powers within 31 the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, similar to that of the 32



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Division of Conservation and Resources Enforcement within the 1 Department of Land and Natural Resources; and 2 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaiian Homes Commission is requested to submit a copy of the feasibility study, 5 including any necessary proposed legislation, to the Legislature 6 no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular 7 Session of 2023; and 8 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 10 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 11 Hawaiian Homes Commission. 12 13 14 15
