SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

DESIGNATING THE WAIANAE MOKU KUPUNA COUNCIL AS AN ADVISORY RESOURCE TO THE ELECTED MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII REPRESENTING THE WAIANAE MOKU COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, from time immemorial, kupuna have held respected 1 and revered positions within Hawaii's households, families, and 2 communities; and 3 4 WHEREAS, kupuna today play an essential role in advising on 5 appropriate actions that enable smooth and efficient 6 relationships among members of households, families, businesses, 7 8 and the community; and 9 WHEREAS, the Waianae Moku community recently formed the 10 Waianae Moku Kupuna Council comprised of kupuna who are sixty 11 12 years of age or older and are long-time residents of Westside Oahu and Hawaiian cultural practitioners who possess historical 13 and cultural knowledge about the Waianae Moku community; and 14 15 WHEREAS, it is of great significance to the Waianae Moku 16 community to have the Waianae Moku Kupuna Council be able to 17 18 meet with elected officials representing the Waianae Moku community on a regular basis to provide, in the spirit of aloha 19 and with humility, input on various issues that are of 20 importance to the Waianae Moku community; and 21 22 WHEREAS, formal recognition of the Waianae Moku Kupuna 23 Council as an advisory resource to elected members of the 24 Legislature of the State of Hawaii who represent the Waianae 25 Moku community is imperative to enable the Council to share its 26 wisdom and advice on matters of importance to the Waianae Moku 27 community; now, therefore, 28 29 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 30 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the 31 32 House of Representatives concurring, that the Waianae Moku

Kupuna Council is designated by the Legislature of the State of 1 Hawaii as an advisory resource to its elected members 2 representing the Waianae Moku community; and 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that elected members of the 5 Legislature of the State of Hawaii representing the Waianae Moku 6 community is requested to meet with the Waianae Moku Kupuna 7 Council on a regular basis to receive input on various issues 8 that are of importance to the Waianae Moku community; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 11 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 12 13 Waianae Moku Kupuna Council. 14 15 16
