SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DRUG ENFORCEMENT AGENCY TO ASSIST THE HAWAII DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH WITH OBTAINING A FEDERAL EXEMPTION FOR THE STATE AUTHORIZED USE OF CANNABIS IN HAWAII.

WHEREAS, the ongoing conflict between state and federal 1 regulation of cannabis is causing devastating consequences for 2 Hawaii's lawfully registered medical cannabis patients and 3 licensed dispensaries; and 4 5 6 WHEREAS, the Legislature addressed the conflict by 7 unanimously adopting House Concurrent Resolution No. 132, Regular Session of 2021 (H.C.R. No. 132), requesting the Hawaii 8 Department of Health to file a federal exemption application for 9 the state authorized use of cannabis in Hawaii with the Drug 10 Enforcement Administration; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the Department of Health has resisted moving 13 forward with this request because of potential negative 14 repercussions for the State's medical cannabis program; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, states have reserved the authority to decide how cannabis is regulated within their jurisdiction; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the federal appropriations rider known as the 20 Rohrabacher-Farr Amendment, which prevents the Department of 21 Justice and the Drug Enforcement Administration from using 22 resources to interfere with state medical cannabis programs 23 continues to be in force; now, therefore, 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 26 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the 27 House of Representatives concurring, that the Drug Enforcement 28 Administration is requested to assist the Hawaii Department of 29 Health with obtaining a federal exemption for the state 30 31 authorized use of cannabis in Hawaii; and 32
